

YELLOW/RED CARD SYSTEM

Home teams are responsible for their own behaviour as well as the opposition. Teams should make visitors aware of the system.

YELLOW CARD

Where teams are in breach of the conditions listed under a yellow card scheme, a letter will be issued. A yellow card will stay on record for three home games. If a team receives more than two yellow cards a season, it will result in an automatic four-week ban.

- Litter around the pitch.
- Not storing equipment properly.
- Not cleaning the home and away changing rooms.
- Washing kit or boots in sinks or showers.
- Banging footwear on the walls
- Using facilities, equipment and / or pitch when games are not booked with the Parish Council.
- Disturbance and /or nuisance and/or annoyance by excessive noise.

RED CARD

Where a team is in breach of any of the conditions listed under the Red Card scheme, a letter will be issued, and it will result in an automatic four-week ban. Should a team receive more than two Red cards in a season, **facilities will be withdrawn**

- Training on any pitches or open space without a booking.
- Foul or abusive, racist, sexist or homophobic language towards, staff, residents and other park users.
- Wilful damage (teams will be charged for putting right ant damage)
- Playing on an unfit pitch. (teams will be charged for reinstatement)
- Urinating or defecating in public.
- Smoking within the buildings.
- Drug use across the facility
- Drinking alcohol across the facility
